

## **Description of Weekend Activities**

Horse Fan Badge- A beginning badge on safety around horses, and learning the parts of a saddle and bridle, and “hands on” saddling a horse.

Horse Rider Badge- an explanation of safety, and going over the different tools used for grooming a horse and “hands on” grooming.

Horse Sense Badge- an interest project will help you better understand horses, safety, careers and hobbies that involve horses. There are some things to do on your own. (CADETTE LEVEL)

Scavenger Hunt- small groups collect things that can be safely returned to the environment; or things that do not belong and negatively impact the environment.

Wildlife Badge- a discussion of our state animals, flowers, etc. with conservation and environmental games emphasizing wildlife.

Orienteering- basic introduction to the use of the compass and practice in pacing and measuring distance. Simple courses complete with obstacles are followed.

Fossil Study- a visit to the limestone quarry including an explanation of its development in geologic time and discussion of fossil formation. Instruction on using hammers and goggles is included.

Initiative Tasks- group problem solving tasks which emphasize cooperation and patience.

Critter Corral- a guided visit to the corral to see and pet the smaller animals of the farm.

Mapping- a fun question and answer hunt to help you become familiar with your surroundings.

Games- a counselor’s or kids’ choice of fun indoor or outdoor games.

Canyon Hike- a scenic, self-guided trail through field, forest, stream and into the sand stone canyon.
